HY/2009/19 - Tunnel (North Point Section) and Island Eastern Corridor Link

- AECOM briefed Members on the progress of works under Contract No. HY/2011/08 - Tunnel Buildings, Systems and Fittings, and Works associated with Tunnel Commissioning (CC) and Contract No. HY/2009/19 - Tunnel (North Point Section) and Island Eastern Corridor Link (C19). Noted
- 3.1.1 Construction activities carried out by CC and C19: Noted
- a. Works on road resurfacing, road markings, and replacement of traffic signs and directional signs at Connaught Road Central elevated road westbound near Wing On Centre, Connaught Road Central westbound near China Travel Building and Connaught Road Central westbound near Statue Square;
 - b. Road improvement works at Yiu Sing Street, Man Yiu Street, Edinburgh Place and Lung Wo Road.
- 3.1.2 The upcoming construction activities to be carried out by CC and C19: Noted
- a. Replacement of directional signs at Man Kat Street/ Man Kwong Street, Man Po Street and Connaught Road Central. The works were anticipated to be completed in the second quarter of 2020;
 - b. Road improvement works at Yiu Sing Street;
 - c. Installation of chainage markers at Connaught Road Central elevated road. Special traffic arrangements (full closure of eastbound for 2-3 nights and temporary traffic arrangement for westbound) would be implemented to facilitate the works, which were anticipated to be completed in the second quarter of 2020.
- 4 Retaining of Rumsey Street Flyover (RSF) Eastbound Down Ramp**
- 4.1 AECOM briefed Members on the preliminary works scheme at Connaught Road Central elevated road for the retaining of Rumsey Street Flyover (RSF) eastbound down ramp. The works included drainage works, modification/removal of existing parapets, installation/removal of lighting equipments, removal of existing central divider, connecting the 2 ramp structures of RSF eastbound and westbound carriageway, road formation works and landscape works. Temporary traffic arrangement would be implemented on Connaught Road Central elevated road westbound during the works.

- 5.1 ET reported to Members on the environmental monitoring and audit work carried out over the past six months at the following monitoring stations near the construction sites. Noted
- i) Noise monitoring stations
 - Eastern Wing of IFC
 - Western Wing of IFC

 - ii) Air quality monitoring stations
 - Eastern end of the podium of IFC
 - Western end of the podium of IFC
- 5.2 ET reported that according to the air quality monitoring results and noise monitoring results from September 2019 to February 2020, no exceedance of both air quality monitoring and noise monitoring was recorded. Noted
- 5.3 ET concluded that the construction works had progressed in compliance with the environmental requirements. Noted
